### Notification


Thimphu Thromde would like to notify the general public that, an increasing number of livestock (in particular cattle and the horses) are found stray within the Thimphu Thromde causing inconvenience to the general public, causing traffic congestion, destroying all the beautification works, micro gardens and kitchen gardens.

Thimphu Thromde would like to seek support and efforts from the livestock owners to refrain from releasing livestock beyond the private premises. The livestock owners are requested to be responsible for taking proper care and control of livestock within private premises preventing it from wandering and causing damage to private and public property or causing public nuisance.

Thimphu Thromde shall impound stray livestock and shall be released on payment of fine amounting to Nu. 1500 per day for each livestock. For repeated offence, double the payment shall be imposed. In case the stray livestock is not claimed within **Five Days**, then the Thimphu Thromde shall have the option to sell, auction or handover the unclaimed stray livestock as per Section 15 of the Waste Prevention and Management Regulations (2012) to Semchen Tsethar Tshogpa who can better look after stray livestock.

Kindly be informed that henceforth, if the owner claims for stray livestock after being handed over to the Semchen Tsethar Tshogpa, Thimphu Thromde shall not entertain the return of the livestock.
